Some 90 print pundits from Taiwan, Hong Kong and South China visited the KBA stand at Drupa

A special show for some 90 Chinese visitors took place on the KBA stand on 2 June. They came from Taiwan, Hong Kong and South China to find out all about KBA sheetfed offset technology in 2.5 days. Most of them already operate Rapida presses in their companies.

The Europe trip began at the plant in Radebeul where the visitors got first glimpses of the latest techno-

logy. The next stop was Drupa in Düsseldorf. Here, KBA sales director Dietmar Heyduck welcomed them to the KBA stand in perfect Chinese. They then watched a live demonstration of the almost 35m-long Rapida 145. This was followed by a demo of the Rapida 106 with LED-UV. The visitors returned home after seeing the sights of Frankfurt.

Druck- und Pressehaus Naumann from Gelnhausen, Germany, has ordered a highly automated KBA Commander CL newspaper web press from Koenig & Bauer at Drupa 2016. The press line can print up to 90,000 full-colour newspapers per hour. The Commander CL has been the most ordered high-performance newspaper press in its class since its market launch. KBA has since sold 16 of these press lines to customers in Germany, France, China and the USA.

Druck- und Pressehaus Naumann in Gelnhausen is a modern media company which publishes Germany's youngest independent daily newspaper, the Gelnhäuser Neue Zeitung.

The Commander CL ordered will have two eight-high towers for 4/4 printing, a KF 5 jaw folder, two Pastomat reelstands plus a Patras M automatic

reel-loading system as well as an extensive package of automation modules. The press line will be fired up in summer 2017.

High-end Rapida 106 for Bangladesh



Bangladesh's first Rapida 106 will be delivered at the end of August. NRG Printing & Packaging decided in favour of the no.1 in packaging printing and the world makeready champion in sheetfed offset with this investment. The company operates 18 sheetfed offset presses. The seven-colour Rapida 106 with coater and UV kit will soon ensure that the company can target new markets.

NRG is one of Bangladesh's largest textile manufacturers and has had its own printing company with 175 staff and a head office in Dhaka since 2007. The Rapida 106 will be in-

stalled in the printing plant in Jamir-dia. The new press will be equipped with a cardboard and plastics package and will be raised by 450mm. Print quality will be controlled via ErgoTronic ColorDrive and LogoTronic Professional links pre-press and MIS.

NRG Printing & Packaging produces food packaging and folding carton for the cosmetic industry and pharmaceutical products. Customers include international brand names, such as Nestlé and Unilever. The new press is expected to produce print products, which previously were imported from India, directly in Bangladesh.
